

## CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

### 1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf will be used throughout the events.

### 2. COMPETITION DETAILS

During the calendar year, generally on the first Saturday of each month, a Monthly Medal event will be played over 18 holes of Single Stroke. The competition date may vary due to calendar, course and weather considerations, at the discretion of the Match Committee.

An Eclectic Competition will take place in conjunction with each Monthly Medal event (or other events as determined by the Committee). Competitors may play up to twelve rounds and their eclectic score is the lowest stroke score obtained for each hole during the eligible rounds.

The Eclectic Event is open to all players that have entered their name on the Entry Sheet and paid the Entry Fee to the Pro. After the first round, entries will be accepted at any time during the calendar year. All such entries shall be in writing, accompanied by the entry fee and witnessed by an authorised person (Admin, Committee or Pro) prior to the competitor's first eligible round.

The Eclectic Competition Fee is payable prior to a player joining the competition. Any scores returned by a player prior to entering the competition do not form part of their eclectic score.

In the event a round is cancelled (due to course/weather conditions) after the start of play, all scores for the Medal and Eclectic will be invalid. If sufficient rounds have been completed, prizes may be awarded for a partial-field competition of the day.

### 3. MONTHLY MEDAL GRADES

The player's handicap as at the start of the round shall determine the player's grade in the monthly Medal. Generally, the grades are:

'A' Grade	0 – 13
'B' Grade	14 – 19
'C' Grade	20 – 36.

### 4. ECLECTIC HANDICAP

Exactly half of the player's handicap as at the start of the last round (usually December) shall determine the player's handicap for the Net Events.

### 5. MONTHLY MEDAL PRIZES

Depending on the number of competitors, prizes may be awarded in the following categories:

Monthly Medal Winner	Best Net – each grade.
Runners-Up Net	2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> each grade (or as determined by the committee).
Best Gross Score	Lowest Gross Score – each grade.
Nearest The Pin	Holes 5, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 16.
Pro Pin	Hole 2 – open to all players that have entered their name on the entry sheet and paid the fee to the Pro.

There will also be a "Ball Rundown" as determined by the Event Committee.

### 6. ECLECTIC PRIZES

Prizes are awarded in the following categories:

Net Winner	Lowest Net Eclectic score.
Gross Winner	Lowest Gross Eclectic score.

A competitor may win only one prize. If necessary, prizes will be awarded to the next best score in each category. Depending on the number of entries, the Event Committee may also award several novelty and/or mystery prizes.

### 7. TIES

All prizes will be decided by the Australian Countback System.
