

# FOURBALL STROKE

## CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

### 1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf will be used throughout this event.

### 2. COMPETITION DETAILS

The competition will be played over 18 holes of Fourball Stroke.

Tee timeslots are offered using a competition timesheet. Entries will be accepted on the day of play if tee times are available. The competition fee is payable before the round.

### 3. SOLO PLAYERS / SWING PLAYERS

It is preferable to establish partners in this event. The starter has the authority to move players into groups to avoid having solo players. However, if a player is in a group of three and does not have a partner, the solo player shall play as a team with the lower handicapped player (the "swing player") of the intact pair.

Failure to follow the above procedure will result in disqualification. 2-ball groups are not allowed.

The swing player shall only be eligible for one prize (voucher, trophy or ball-rundown) unless he/she pays a second competition fee.

### 4. QUEENSLAND HANDICAP FOURBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The leading two pairs from this club event will have their scores matched against other club qualifiers in the District to determine the District Representatives. The leading two pairs from the District qualify for the Queensland Handicap Fourball Championship to be held at Club Pelican in October. A Handicap Limit of 36 applies.

The club will invite the winners and place-getters to represent the club. The club will pay the entry fees (currently \$150 per pair) for the State Final for the successful pairings.

Qualifiers for the finals must be male members of MCGC. Junior players are not eligible.

### 5. PRIZES

Prizes are awarded in the following categories:

- Best Score
- Nearest The Pins

1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> or as determined by the committee.  
Holes 5, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 16 or as determined by the committee.

There will also be a "Ball Rundown" as determined by the Event Committee.

All prizes will be decided by the Australian Countback System.

### 6. COMPETITION FORMAT

This a variation of the basic Stroke event with two players playing as partners.

After completing each hole, both partners determine their net scores. The actual stroke score is recorded in the appropriate player's column (A or B). The net score is recorded in the "RESULTS" column. If both players achieve the same net score, the first player to hole out has their score recorded.

The total net score for each nine and the overall round are totalled. The net score shall be shown at the top of the card.

The team with the lowest net score is the winner.

To assist with Pace of Play, it is customary for players to pick up their ball once it is obvious that they cannot beat their partner's score.
