

1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf shall be used throughout this event. The Event Committee has sole management and control of the event.

2. COMPETITION ENTRIES

The Mt Coolum Men's Foursomes Championship shall be played over two rounds (18 holes each) as determined by the Match Committee.

Tee timeslots are offered using a competition timesheet. Entries will be accepted on the day if tee times are available. Play will be in groups of six (3 teams).

The Championship Fee is payable prior to the start of the first round. No fee is required prior to the start of the second round.

3. FOURSOMES FORMAT

The team handicap is half the player's combined handicaps. The scorecard must show each player's Golf Link number and handicap, the stroke score for each hole, the signature of one player, the signature of a marker.

The players shall decide who shall tee off on the first tee. The ball is then played alternately until the ball is holed. The other player shall tee off on the second tee, and tee shots alternate throughout the round. The order of play must be reversed at the commencement of the second round. Penalty – Disqualification.

It is the player's responsibility to be aware of the specific rules of golf for Foursomes.

4. DAILY COMPETITIONS

Running concurrently with the Foursomes Championship will be a Foursomes Competitions open to all members. There shall also be a "Ball Rundown" as determined by the Event Committee. Foursomes in the Championship will have the better score from their two Championship rounds entered for the competition of the day.

5. PRIZES

Prizes shall also be awarded in the following categories over 36 holes:

Foursomes Champions	1 st – gross score.
Runners-Up	2 nd – gross score.
Nett Winners	1 st – nett score.
Nett Runners-Up	2 nd – nett score.

The same team shall NOT be awarded both Gross and Nett prizes. If necessary, the prize for Best Nett shall be awarded to the team with the next best nett score.

6. TIES

Gross Event – In the event of a tie (or ties), there shall be a Sudden Death Play-off after the last eligible championship scorecard is returned and checked. The play-off shall use the 18th hole until a winner remains.

If necessary, it is the players' responsibility to be present and ready to commence a play-off 15 minutes after the last group finishes their round.

All other prizes will be decided by the Australian Countback System.

7. USE OF MOTORISED TRANSPORT

Gross Event	Players may use motorised transport.
Nett Event	Players may use motorised transport.
