CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION THIS IS A CHAMPIONSHIP AND BOARD EVENT

1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf shall be used throughout this event. The Event Committee has sole management and control of the event.

2. COMPETITION ENTRIES

The Mt Coolum Mixed Foursomes Championship shall be played over 27 holes (1st to 18th and 1st to 9th) on a date determined by the Event Committee.

Tee timeslots are offered using a competition timesheet. Entries will be accepted on the day of play if tee times are available. Play will be in groups of six players (i.e. three teams).

The Competition Fee is payable prior to the start of the first round.

3. MIXED FOURSOMES FORMAT – SHOTGUN START

A team shall consist of one male player and one female player. The team handicap is half the players' combined handicaps. The scorecard must show each player's GolfLink number and handicap, the stroke score for each hole, the signature of one player, and the signature of a marker.

The male player shall tee off on all odd numbered holes. The ball is then played by the female player and continues alternately until the ball is holed. Similarly, the female player shall tee off on all even numbered holes.

NOTE: It is the players' responsibility to be aware of the specific rules of golf for Foursomes.

Teams will be issued two scorecards each. One for the first 9 holes and one for the remaining 18 holes. As it is a shotgun start, teams will commence play at the "start hole" and will continue through for the "first 9" before playing the "second 18". See the table below for more information.

e.g. a team commencing on the 6th tee will play holes 6, 7, 8 and 9 before continuing their "first 9" on hole 1 through to hole 5. When they tee off on the 6th hole again, that commences their "second 18". And they will play holes 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 to 18, then hole 1 through to 5. There is no meal break, but the halfway hut will be open to supply refreshments.

4. PRIZES

Prizes shall also be awarded in the following categories:

Foursomes Champions & Runners-up

1st & 2nd gross score.

Nett Winners & Runners-up

1st & 2nd nett score.

NTP's – 5th, 12th and 16th holes

2nd Shot – 2nd hole

Other prizes as determined by the Event Committee and depending on the number of entrants may include Second Worst Nett Score and Best 9 Hole Nett Score.

The same team shall NOT be awarded both Gross and Nett prizes. If necessary, the prize for Best Nett shall be awarded to the team with the next best nett score.

There shall also be a "Ball Rundown" as determined by the Event Committee.

5. TIES

Gross Event – In the event of a tie (or ties), there shall be a play-off immediately after the last card is returned and checked. The play-off shall be sudden death using 3 holes (1st, 8th and 9th).

If necessary, it is the players' responsibility to be present and ready to commence a play-off 15 minutes after the last group finishes their round.

All other prizes will be decided by the Australian Countback System.

6. USE OF MOTORISED TRANSPORT

Gross Event	Players may use motorised transport.
Nett Event	Players may use motorised transport.
