

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf shall be used throughout this event. The Event Committee has sole management and control of the event.

2. COMPETITION DETAILS

A 3 Person Ambrose Event shall be played over 9 holes before the start of each year's Pennant Season (if possible). Players from all Men's and Women's teams (including Juniors) will be invited to play with the Management Committee and Club/Pennant Sponsors.

Players are requested to assemble 30 minutes prior to the advertised start time where they will be placed into teams by the Committee. Each group will include both males and females where possible. Where possible, 2 teams of 3 players will play in a group of 6. READY GOLF applies.

Entry is free for all invited players.

3. 3 PERSON AMBROSE – COMPETITION FORMAT

The team handicap is $\frac{1}{12}$ of the combined players' handicap. The scorecard must show each team member's handicap. The scorecard shall be marked and signed by one member of the other team and signed by a member of the team.

All team members tee off each hole. The team chooses the shot they are going to use. The golfer whose shot is taken is eliminated from participating in the next shot. A player is only eliminated for the one shot following their selected shot.

The other members retrieve their balls and all players, in turn, PLACE their ball within one club-length of the selected position, no nearer the hole, and play their second shots. This procedure of selecting a ball and two shots being played continues until a ball is holed.

When on the green, balls are PLACED within one card-length of the selected spot.

Each team member's tee shot must be used at least TWO (2) times during the round. The Scorer must record whose tee shot was used on EVERY hole. If this is not clearly marked on the card, the team may be subject to disqualification.

Each ball must be placed on the same surface (fairway, rough, green, fringe or sand) as where the selected ball was marked. In a sand bunker, the sand may be raked prior to placing the ball.

4. GOLF PRIZES

The Prizes for the best Ambrose scores shall be awarded depending on the number of entries and as determined by the Event Committee.

Nearest The Pins – as determined by number of players and the Event Committee.

5. TIES

In the event of a tie (or ties) prizes and places will be decided by the Australian Countback System and the Event Committee. The decision of the Committee is final.

6. USE OF MOTORISED TRANSPORT

Players may use motorised transport.
