CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

ALSO KNOWN AS "AMERICAN FOURSOMES"

1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf shall be used throughout this event. The Event Committee has sole management and control of the event.

2. COMPETITION ENTRIES

Tee timeslots are offered using a competition timesheet. Entries will be accepted on the day of play if tee times are available. The Competition Fee is payable prior to the start of the round.

3. FOURSOMES PARTNERSHIPS

It is compulsory to establish partners in this event. The starter has the authority to move players into groups to avoid having solo players.

4. 2 STROKE CANADIAN FOURSOMES FORMAT

The team handicap is 3/8 of the player's combined handicaps. The scorecard must show each player's Golf Link number and handicap, the stroke score for each hole, the signature of one player, the signature of a marker.

Both players play tee shots at each hole then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and played alternately until the ball is holed. That is, the owner of the ball selected plays the third shot.

It is the player's responsibility to be aware of the specific rules of golf for Foursomes.

5. VOUCHERS / PRIZES

Vouchers and prizes shall be awarded as for a typical Saturday 4 Ball competition.

There shall also be a "Ball Rundown" as determined by the Event Committee.\

6. TIES

All places shall be decided by the Australian Countback System.
