

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf will be used throughout this event.

2. ECLECTIC COMPETITION DETAILS

An Eclectic Competition will take place in conjunction with each Monthly Medal event (or other events as determined by the Committee) during a calendar year.

Competitors may play up to approximately twelve (12) rounds (January to December) and their eclectic score is the lowest score obtained for each hole during the eligible rounds.

The Event is open to all players that have entered their name on the Entry Sheet and paid the Entry Fee to the Pro. After the first round, entries will be accepted at any time during the calendar year. All such entries shall be in writing, accompanied by the entry fee and witnessed by a Committee member prior to the competitor's first eligible round.

The Eclectic Competition Fee is payable prior to a player joining the competition. Any scores returned by a player prior to entering the competition do not form part of their eclectic score.

3. HANDICAP

Half of the player's handicap as at the start of the last round shall determine the player's handicap for the Net Events. The maximum handicap is 36.

4. PRIZES

Prizes are awarded in the following categories:

Net Winner	Lowest Net Eclectic score.
Gross Winner	Lowest Gross Eclectic score.
Net Runner-up	2 nd best Net Eclectic score.
Gross Runner-up	2 nd best Gross Eclectic score.

A competitor may win only one prize. If necessary, prizes will be awarded to the next best score in each category.

Depending on the number of entries, the Event Committee may also award several novelty and/or mystery prizes.

5. TIES

All prizes will be decided by the Australian Countback System.
