

## CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

### 1. RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the General Conditions of Competition and the Rules of Golf will be used throughout this event. The Match Committee has sole management and control of the event.

### 2. COMPETITION ENTRIES

The President vs Captain Challenge will be played as a Handicap Match Play event over 18 holes each Easter Saturday and is open to all club members with a current GA handicap. Maximum handicap shall be 36 for men and 45 for women. Entries will be accepted on the day of play if places are available.

Players in the challenge may also play in the club's competition of the day but must complete each hole in accordance with the Competition of the Day rules.

The Competition Fee is payable prior to the start of the round.

### 3. FORMAT

Players shall play individual handicap match play. Players are nominated for each team by an extremely clever and complicated ballot system developed by the President and Captain. No correspondence shall be entered into.

Players will play in a seeded draw as published – penalty a drink for the Captain and President.

### 4. WINNING THE CHALLENGE

The winning team will be that which has the most individual match play wins. Each member of the losing team MUST pay \$20 for the after-match function.

If there is a tie, then the result of the President vs Captain match will determine the winner.

If still tied, the total number of holes “won by” shall determine the winner.

If still tied, ALL players shall contribute \$10 to the after-match function.

### 5. AFTER-MATCH FUNCTION

The two teams will gather after the game for the presentation, taunting and friendly banter, finger food and drinks paid for by the losing team.

This is a fun game intended to create spice to the President vs Captain Trophy event and to mix players in the club who may not usually have the opportunity to play against each other.

All members are encouraged to nominate and play.
